Isaiah's Rock also provides warm meals, daily necessities, emergency shelter, and laundry services to people in need. Their services are provided to not only Chino residents but those in the surrounding areas of Pomona, Montclair, and Ontario.

Prior to the pandemic, Isaiah's Rock provided groceries to anyone in need on Wednesdays and Fridays. When the pandemic struck, it was no longer safe for hundreds of people to gather at the "Little Blue House" at one time to pick up their groceries. Showcasing their passion and dedication to community service, Isaiah's Rock pivoted and began hosting a drive-through food distribution behind Chino City Hall every Wednesday.
