KNOW YOUR *Rights*

- ✓ You have the right to apply for and secure housing without sharing your immigration status.
- ✓ You have the right to access emergency medical care.
- ✓ You have the right to an attorney.
- ✓ State and local law enforcement cannot ask for your immigration status.
- ✓ State and local law enforcement cannot share your personal information.
- ✓ State and local law enforcement cannot assist ICE with immigration enforcement.

DEFENDING *Your Rights*

Stay calm & don't resist.

All persons in the US have constitutional protections, including the **right to remain silent** when questioned or arrested. Being stopped by law enforcement can be frightening, but it's important to stay calm.



If you are pulled over in a traffic stop:

- Ask if the officer is from the police department or immigration
 - **US/Documented Citizens:** Have your papers at all times. Show your documentation.
 - **Undocumented:** You have the right to remain silent.



If an officer knocks on your door:

- Do **NOT** open the door, and teach your children to do the same.
- Officers can only enter your home if they have a **signed warrant by a JUDGE**, not ICE officers.



If you think immigration officers are nearby:

- Move to a safe indoor space.
- If you are a US citizen and feel safe to do so, **record the activity with your phone or write down any relevant information** on what was witnessed.



If you need support:

- **Ask for an attorney.** Do not sign or make any decisions without a lawyer.
- **Ask to contact your consulate.**
